
# FOURMILE

## TRAVEL MANAGEMENT AR<mark>ea</mark>



#### Please observe these guidelines.

- . Use only **roads and trails designated** for your vehicle type.
- . Do not create new roads and trails.
- . No OHV riding or play in campsites.
- . Limit parking to compacted areas within one vehicle-length from a road or trail.
- . Camping is limited to 14 days.
- . Camp only in existing sites. Do not expand sites or create new sites.

ANAGEM

- . Camp away from **streams** and **water** to avoid polluting waterways and creating erosion.
- . Know and observe current fire restrictions.
- . Use existing campfire rings; do not build new rings.
- . Gather only **down & dead wood**, or purchase wood locally.
- . Bring drinking water and plenty of water to extinguish campfires thoroughly.
- . Consider using a **portable propane fire pit**.
- . A portable toilet system is recommended.
- . Pack out all trash and dispose of dog waste.

#### Remember:

- . 20mph speed limit on Fourmile motorized system routes.
- . Children under 10 years cannot operate OHVs on public roads.
- OHV operators **between ages 10 and 16 must be directly supervised** by a state licensed driver. cpw.state.co.us/thingstodo/Pages/OHVsRegulations.aspx
